

BOARDING SCHOOL MENTOR - VOLUNTARY - ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS PROVIDED

Position Description:

We are seeking energetic and motivated individuals to volunteer at our college and boarding house. Successful applicants will be good role models for our current boarders. You will be provided with accommodation, free internet, power and meals as well as use of our facilities such as the swimming pool and weights room. We will also provide a stipend to cover other essential living costs.

We have four positions that are available for the whole school year of 2021.

Times and days of work are rostered, though you can expect to work at least 15 to 20 hours per week.

When you are rostered on, during the school day (Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 3pm), you will be needed to work for three hours. You will then work from 3pm to 5pm and an additional half hour during the evening to help students. You will also need to work for 4 hours over one weekend a month.

The roster is flexible and we are happy to take your commitments into account.

The roles and responsibilities you will be involved will include:

- Supervision and mentoring in our boarding house
- Working in classrooms alongside teachers
- Working with our Director of Sports
- Working with the school's admin and support team

It is preferred that you have a full driver's licence but this is not required.
